

**YPSILANTI HERITAGE FESTIVAL**

You are invited to apply for a booth at the 31<sup>st</sup> Ypsilanti Heritage Festival, drawing over 80,000 in attendance over a three-day period. The Heritage Festival is one of southeastern Michigan's oldest and largest events. Arts & crafts, children's activities, music, re-enactments, good things to eat and many other activities will round out this celebration of community and history. Please join us for three days and evenings of fun at Riverside Park overlooking the picturesque Huron River. Historic Ypsilanti, founded in 1823, is only minutes from the neighboring communities of Canton, Chelsea, Plymouth, Belleville, and Ann Arbor.

**Application**

- Please include completed application, fee, and 3 photos of the following: one photo of works to be sold, one of the booth or display, and one of the exhibiting artist at work. Please label each photo with name and media. No photos will be returned
- Attach a full list of all items to be sold
- Applications are reviewed by a jury on the context described and photos submitted. The jury's decision is final.
- A notification of acceptance or rejection will be sent to you

**Fees**

- Booth spaces are \$125.00 per 10 x 10 area. (Application received after May 1, 2009, \$150)
- An "upgraded" space with electricity is an additional \$25.00

**Responsibilities:**

- Exhibitors are responsible for their own booth, tables, chairs and displays. They should be prepared for uneven ground, pavement or grass
- Exhibitors who have requested electricity need to provide a minimum of 100 feet of electrical cord.
- Exhibitors must collect and remit 6% Michigan sales tax to the state. Call Michigan Department of treasury at 1-800-367-6263 for more information
- All items sold at the festival are to be made by the artist.
- No work is to be sold that has not been listed on the application and approved
- Any exhibitor determined to be engaged in commercially made or buy/sell items will be asked to leave without a refund
- Exhibitor's pets are not allowed in the park per Ypsilanti city ordinance
- Set up will begin at 5pm Thursday evening
- It is the responsibility of the artist/crafters to secure their booth and exhibits overnight
- All vehicles must be out of the park by 11:30am on Friday morning so the festival can open at noon
- Booths are to remain open during the festival hours and close when the festival closes
- **You may not dismantle your booth or exhibit until 7pm Sunday evening**
- **No cars are permitted into the park on Sunday evening until the ok is given by the City of Ypsilanti Police Chief.**
